GIVE me a Chance Children's Foundation is determined to set a new world record.

The foundation entered a charity bond for the 2012 Cape Argus Pick n Pay Cycle Tour (11 March 2012) and wants to see if the foundation can set a world record for the number of people riding in a timed cycle race for one charity.

Chas Everitt will be the main sponsor for the world record setting attempt by the Chas Everitt Give me a Chance Cycle Team.

"Riding the Cape Argus Pick n Pay Cycle tour is a fund-raising event for the less fortunate children. We are leading property people with a passion for justice, and we understand that our country's sustainable future will depend on the opportunities created for the children of our land," said Berry Everitt, MD of Chas Everitt.

Give me a Chance was started in 2004 by Delarey and Sandie Brugman.

"The Foundation wants to give an opportunity to promising children who have proven their courage way above the challenges of poverty and who have demonstrated some form of achievement against all odds. We believe that children, when given the opportunity, have the ability to help themselves to succeed," said Brugman.

adopted by Give me a Chance in 2004. Marco was given a shot at life and with the help of the director, Lourens Oosthuizen, he is currently doing his articles at BKR Logista in Stellenbosch.

This past year there were several charity events held in support of Give me a Chance.

Daniel Vivier, student at the Stellenbosch University, went on a solo cycle tour from Beit Bridge, the most northern point in South Africa, to Cape Agulhas,

the most southern point in South Africa. He cycled 3 442 km in 37 days. He managed to collect more than R11 000 for the foundation. In July a group of eight cyclist got on their mountain bikes and cycled from Bellville to Knysna and raised funds in excess of R20 000.
